INSTRUCTIONS FOR Application for Unreasonable Hardship Exception to Accessibility Requirements

Do not write in shaded Office Use Only areas on this application.

A. Enter the Project name and address

Enter the Clovis permit number

Provide contact information for the Project Representative/Administrator and Architect of Record for the project. Enter the estimated construction cost of the project or contract amount

- B. Check the appropriate box to indicate under which exemption this application is made. New and existing facilities where alterations are performed must comply with the accessibility requirements of Chapter 11B of the California Building Code (CBC). Exceptions are provided for 'Unreasonable Hardship' in two circumstances:
 - Remodel projects where the cumulative construction cost of all projects in the remodel area for the past three years does <u>not</u> exceed a 'Valuation Threshold' specified in Section 1134B.2.1, Exception 1 of the CBC.

Note: The threshold is adjusted annually based on the year the final construction documents were submitted. The threshold amount can be found at: http://www.dgs.ca.gov/dsa/Programs/progAccess/threshold.aspx

- 2. Unreasonable Hardship may also be granted for projects based on the five criteria listed in the definition of 'Unreasonable Hardship' section 202 of the CBC.
- C. For projects under the Valuation Threshold, the CBC allows a determination of Unreasonable Hardship to be made when the cost of providing the specific accessible elements listed in Section 1134B.2.1 (primary entrance, path of travel, sanitary facilities, accessible telephones, and accessible drinking fountains) is considered disproportionate to the cost of the project. As defined in Section 1134B.2.1, the cost of providing those accessible features is considered disproportionate' when it exceeds 20% of the cost of the project without providing those accessible elements.

Indicate whether or not the specified elements already meet current accessibility requirements, if they will be made to comply with current accessibility requirements as a part of this project, and the cost of making the element accessible, if applicable. Provide the total cost of the specified accessible elements and the total cost of all alteration projects on the same path of travel during the past three years (from Section D). Indicate which elements will be made accessible as a part of this project. The accessible elements must be provided in the order listed in the Section 1134B.2.1 exception until the facility reaches the 20% threshold. If this number exceeds 20%, Unreasonable Hardship may be determined based on this section. Provide additional documentation as required to demonstrate the costs of specific accessible elements.

D. Provide a listing of all projects completed in the last three years for which a minimum of 20% of construction costs were not spent on providing accessible elements. Provide the Clovis permit number, permit date, project description, and project valuation. Provide additional documentation to show construction costs and the amount expended on specific accessible elements.

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- E. Unreasonable Hardship may also be based on the definition of 'Unreasonable Hardship' from Section 202 of the CBC. The code allows a determination of Unreasonable Hardship to be made after evaluating several factors. To perform this evaluation, provide the following: a description of specific accessibility provisions for which an exception is desired, the code section where this requirement is found, whether or not the code required equivalent facilitation, and the cost of making the features accessible. Also, provide the cost of all construction contemplated, the impact of providing access on the project's financial feasibility, and the nature of the accessibility that would be gained or lost. Provide additional documentation as required to demonstrate the costs of specific accessible elements.
- F. The person submitting the Application for Unreasonable Hardship must print the application's name, sign, and date.
- G. "Office Use Only," after reviewing the information on the form, a Clovis Plans Examiner will decide whether to approve or deny the request. In the case of a denial of an Application for Unreasonable Hardship, the applicant may seek an appeal with the Clovis Building Safety Board.

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
