Dear Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in the Clovis FMFCD Representative.

The FMFCD representative for the City of Clovis is a four-year term and can be reappointed for consecutive terms. Board meetings are held on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month at 6:00pm in the District's Board Chambers. The Board approves the District's budget, fees and assessments, directs matters of policy and enacts ordinances, and performs other responsibilities authorized and required by the District's Act. Board Members are compensated \$100.00 per meeting.

The board is made up of a seven-member Board. The City of Fresno appoints four Board Members, the County of Fresno appoints two, and the City of Clovis appoints one. The Board is purposely made up of "citizen" Board Members, which includes teachers, businesspeople, accountants, retired or working. The Board Members' term begins on August 3rd in an even number year and continues for four years terms which can be reappointed for consecutive terms.
