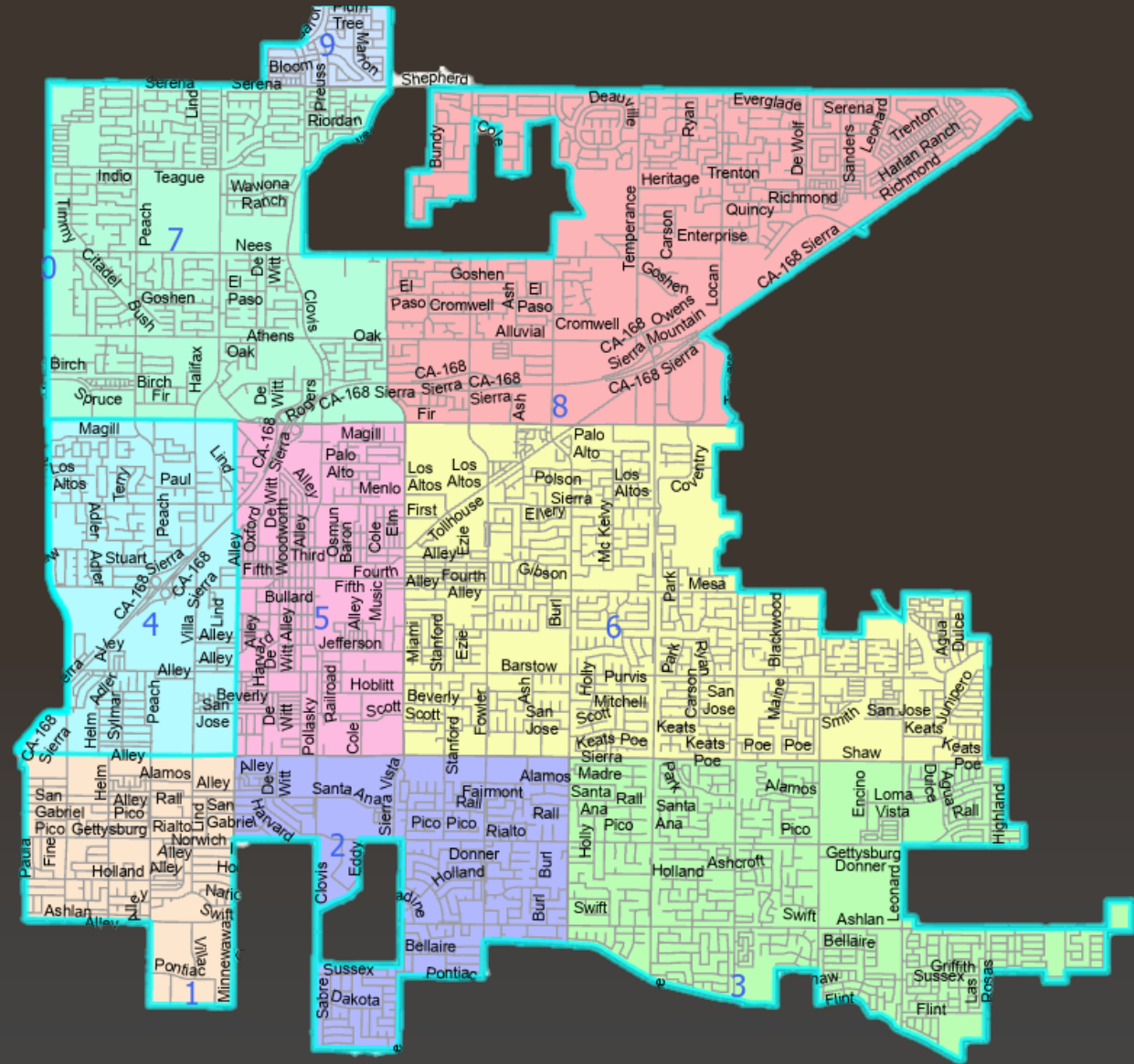

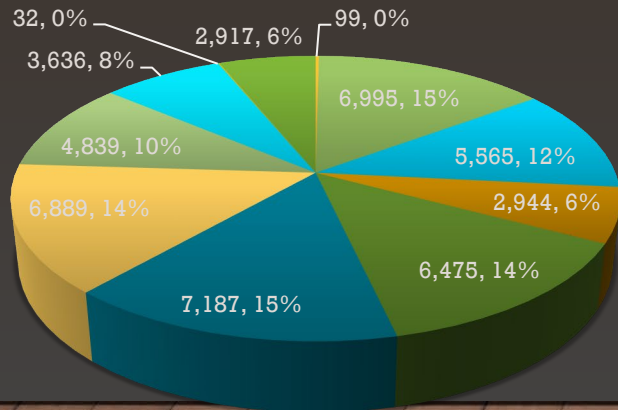

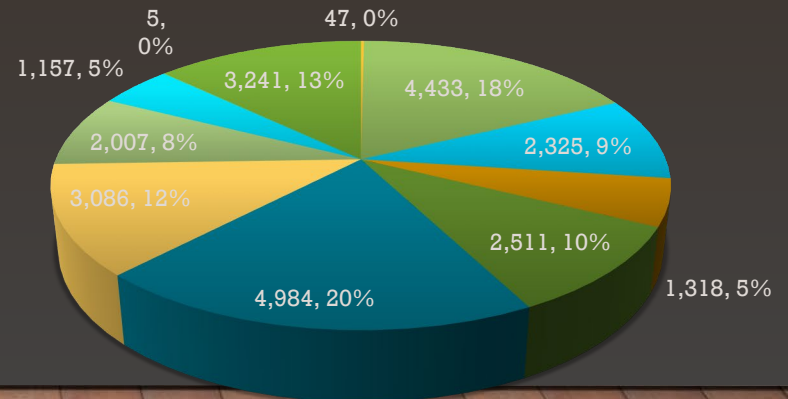
### Public Initiated Incidents by Beat

Officer initiated calls decreased by 14.7%

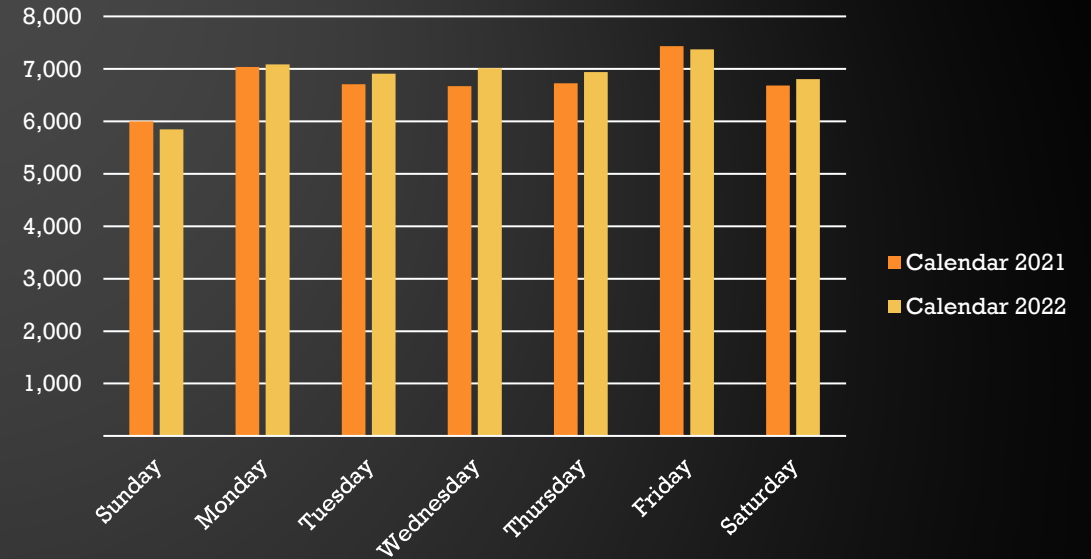
Overall, there was a 4.85% decreased in all calls for service from 2021 to 2022.

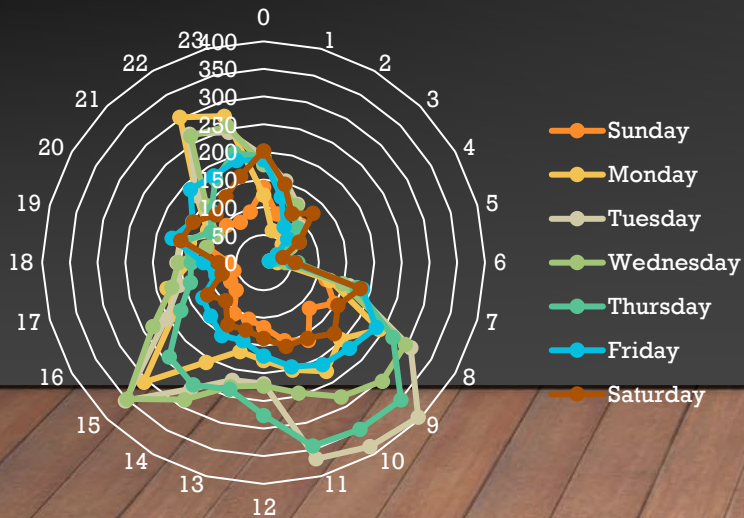
# INCIDENT – TIME OF DAY

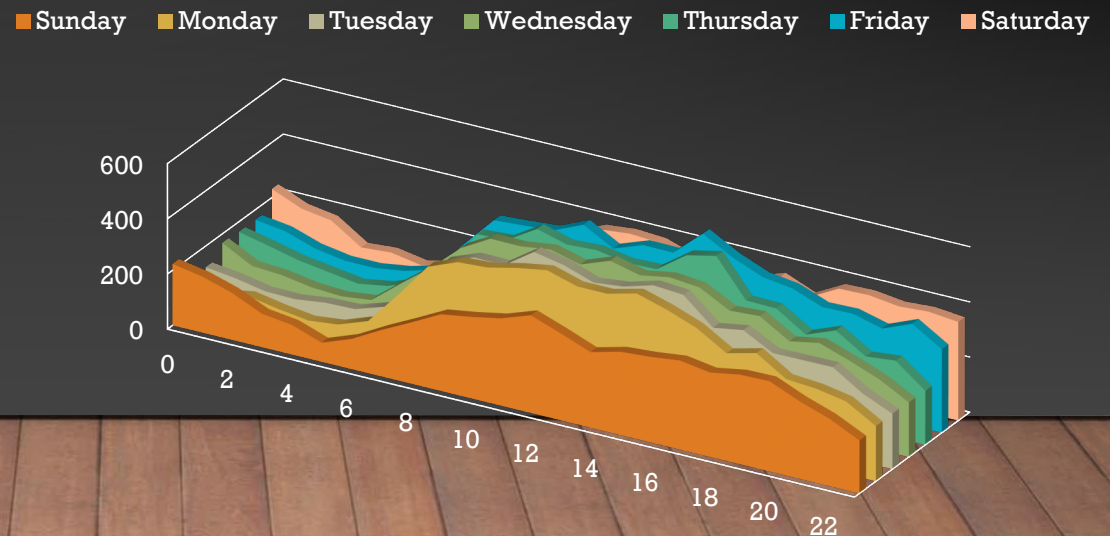

- A decrease in Priority 1 calls from 2021 to 2022. An increase in priority 2's of 5.7% and slight increase of priority 4's. A decrease of priority 3's from 2021 to 2022.

### For Public incidents priority calls:

**Priority 1's:** Highest day is MONDAY and highest time is 1700-1900 hours.

**Priority 2's:** Highest day is FRIDAY and highest time 1600-1700 hours. The overall highest day and time is **THURSDAY AT 1600-1700 hours.**

**Priority 3's:** Highest day is SATURDAY and highest time 2200-2300 hours. The overall highest day and time is **SATURDAY AT 2300-0000 HOURS.**

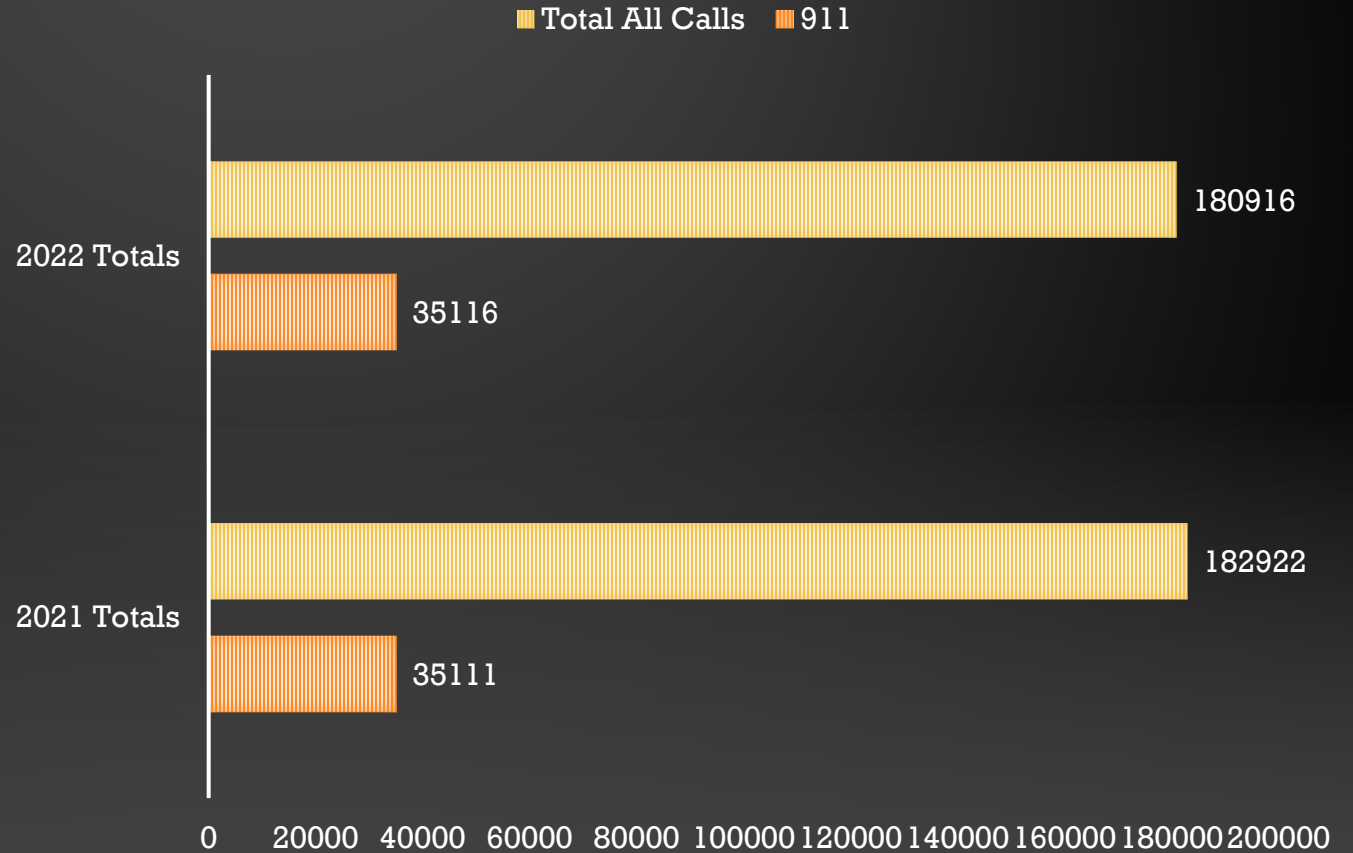


# DISPATCH CALL VOLUME

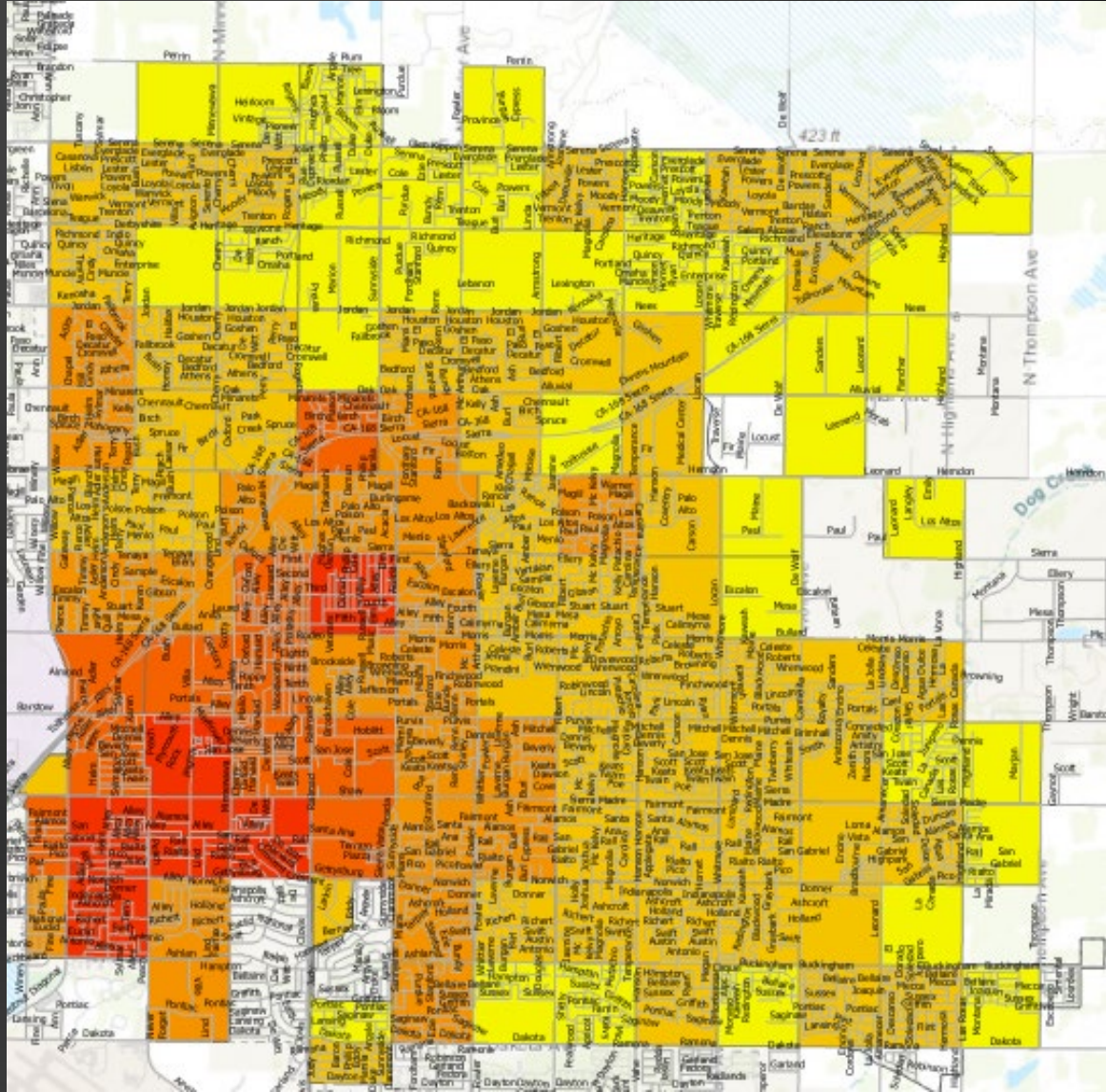

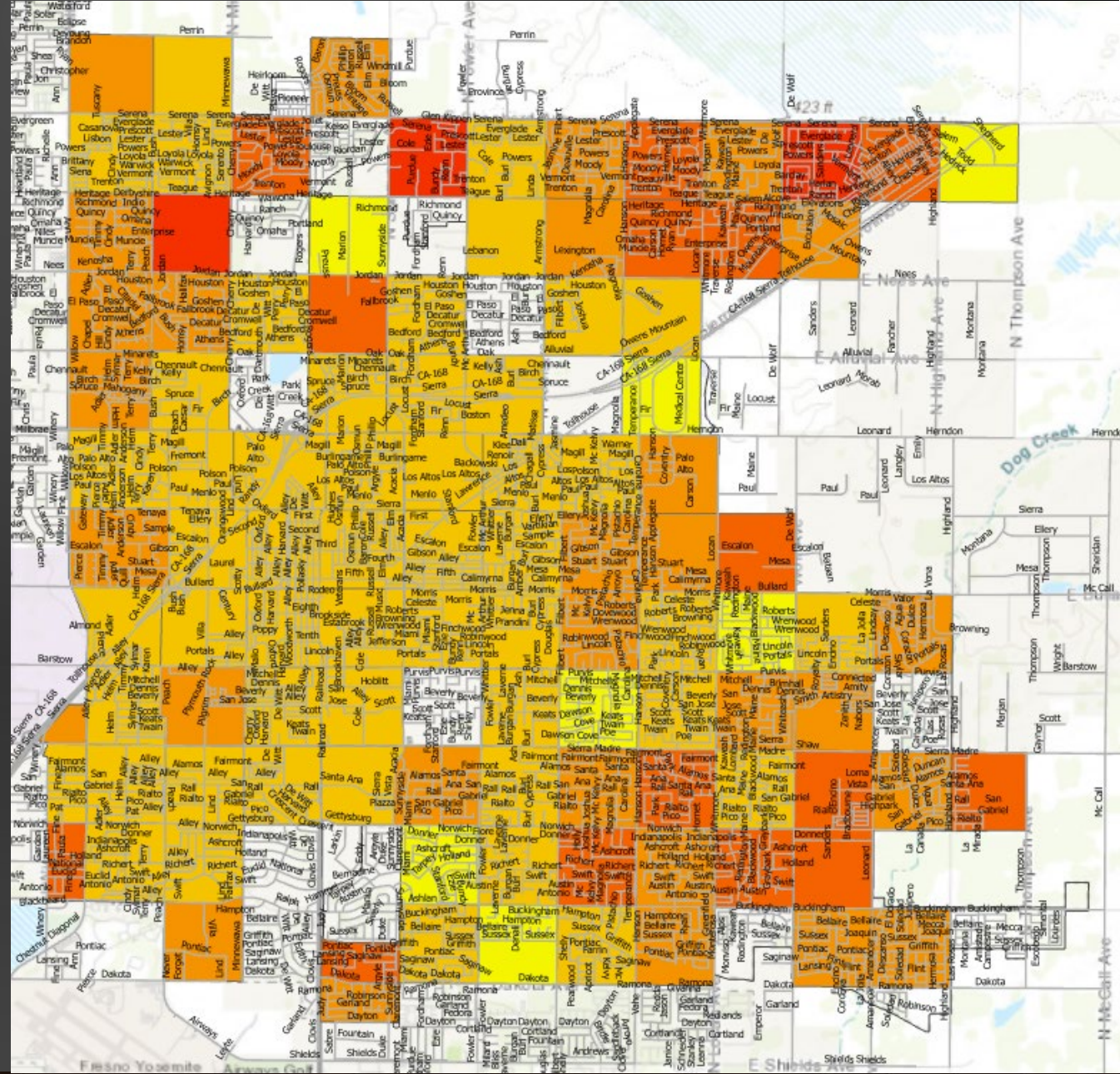

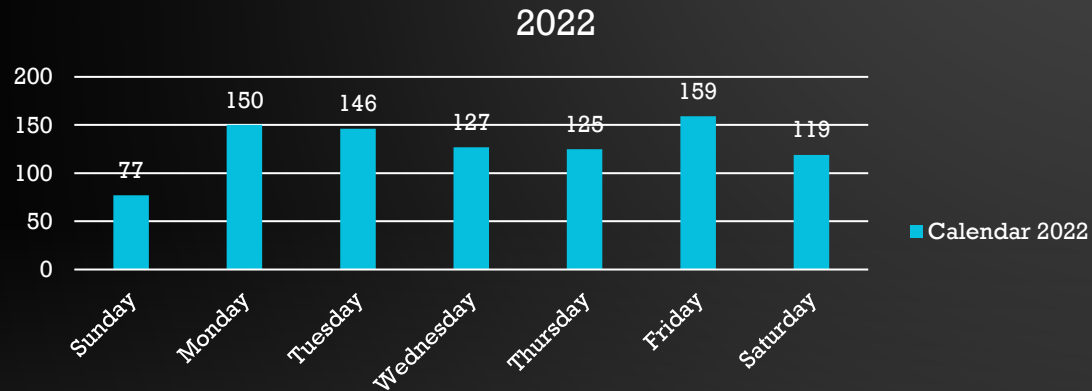

# TRAFFIC CITATIONS

## 25

Clovis Police Department issued 4,106 traffic citations in 2022. This is a decrease of 16% from 2021 where 4,911 traffic tickets were issued.

The top two violations are required registration and unsafe speed. Failure to provide insurance is the third most violation ticketed.

The top 10 intersections for traffic citations are mostly on Shaw and Herndon.

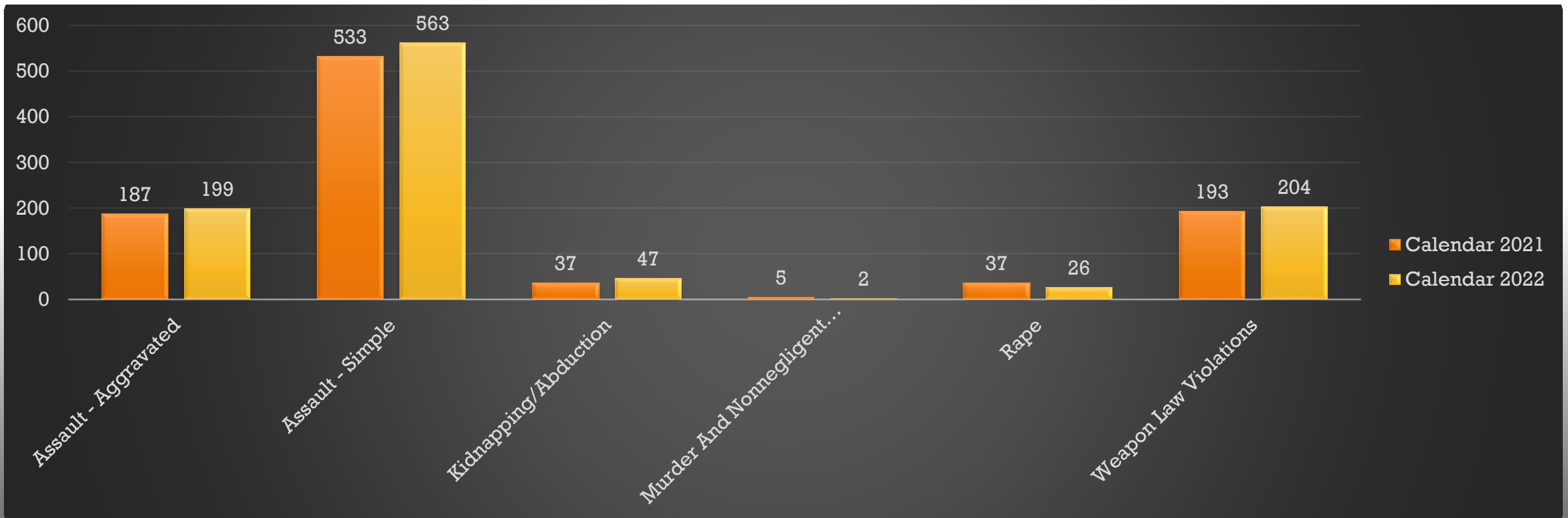

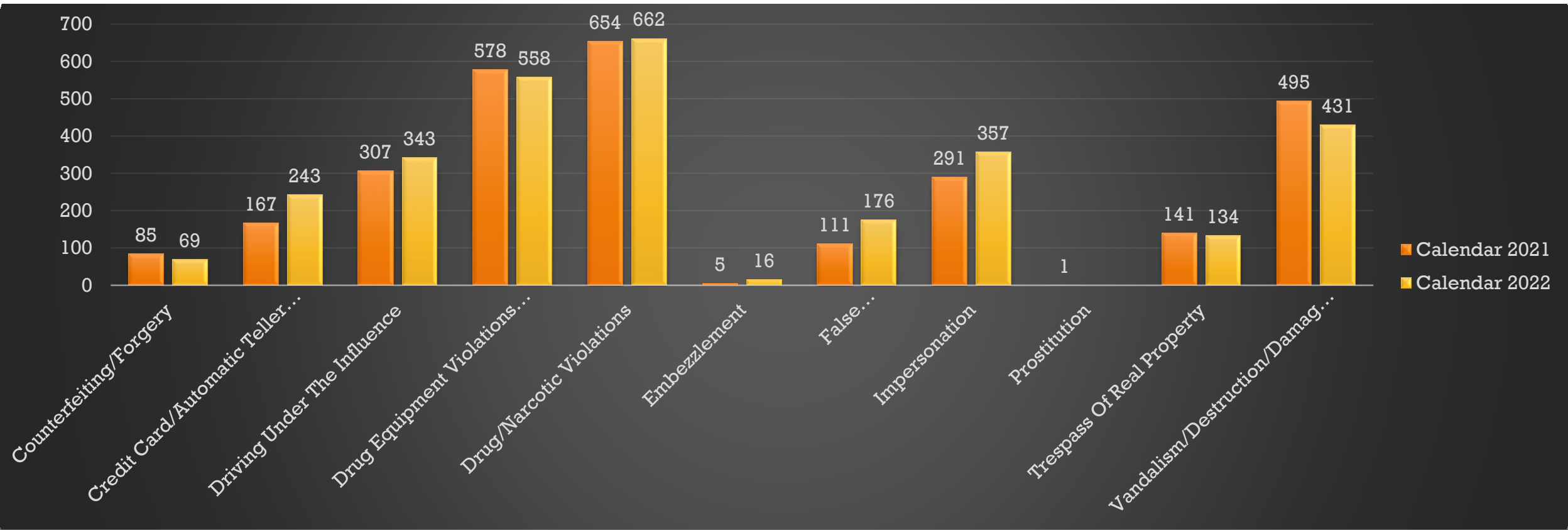
An increase in Assaults, kidnapping and weapons violations. Homicide and rape decreased

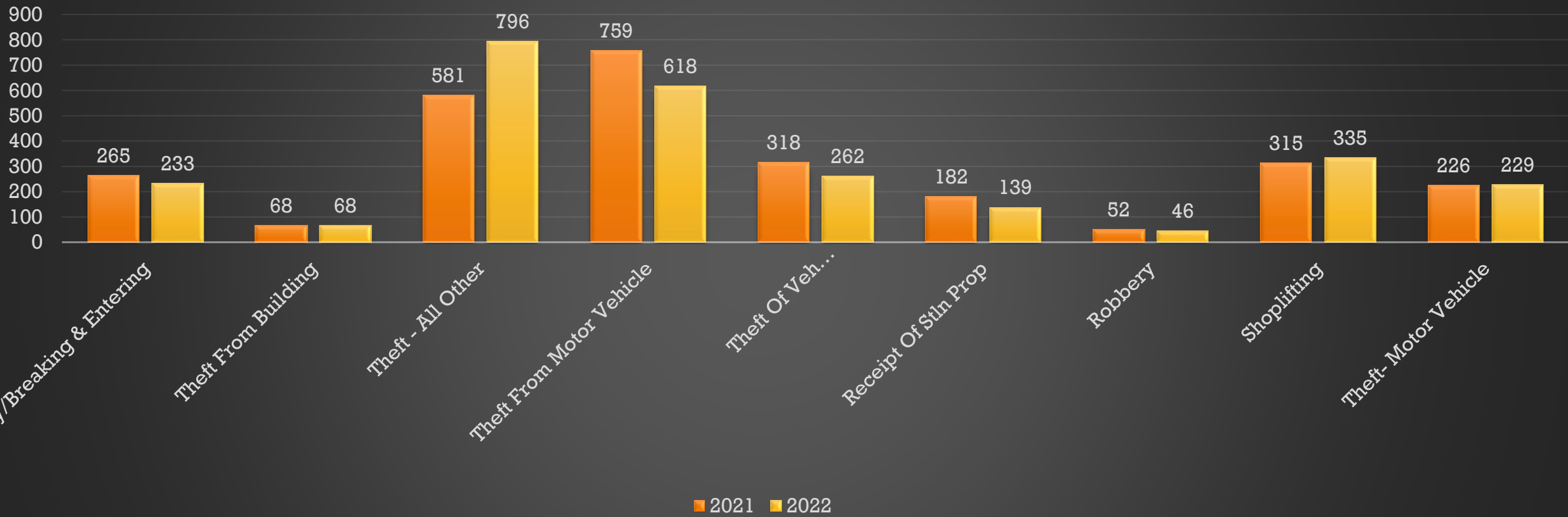

## SEIZED FIREARMS

In 2022 the Clovis Police Department seized 9.4% MORE guns for evidence than in 2021. They also seized 6% more guns for felony cases than in 2021.

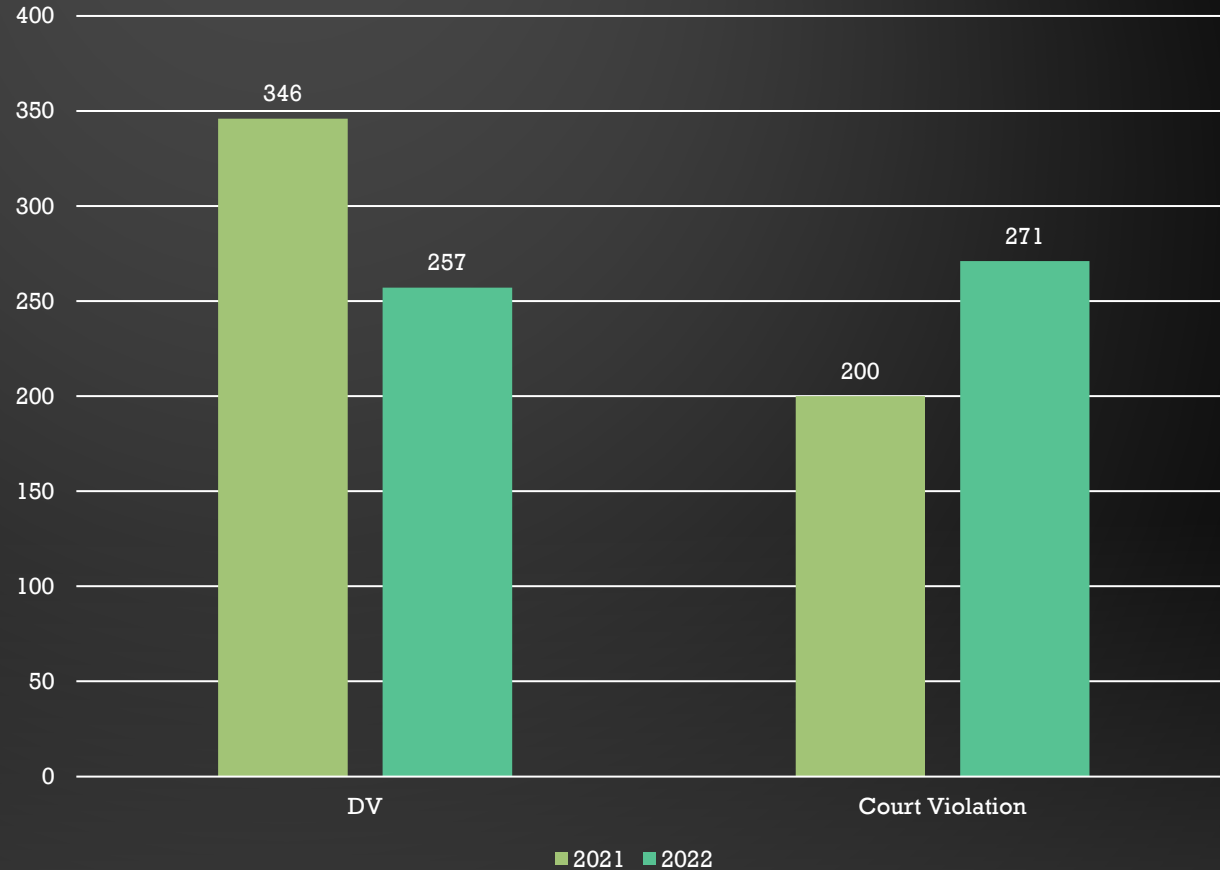

### Domestic Violence 2021 to 2022 Comparison

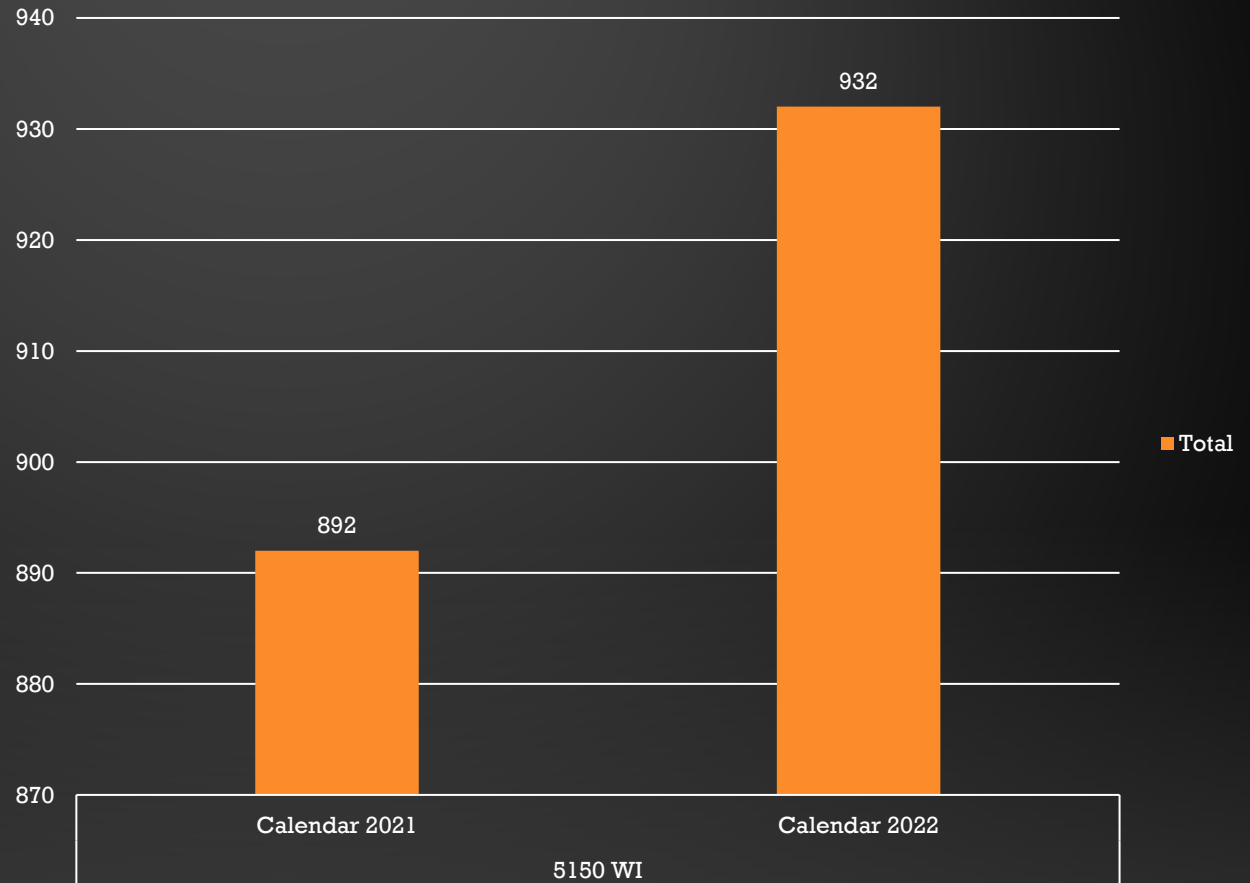


## MENTAL HEALTH

Calls for service dealing with mental health are one of the highest number of calls for service for the Department

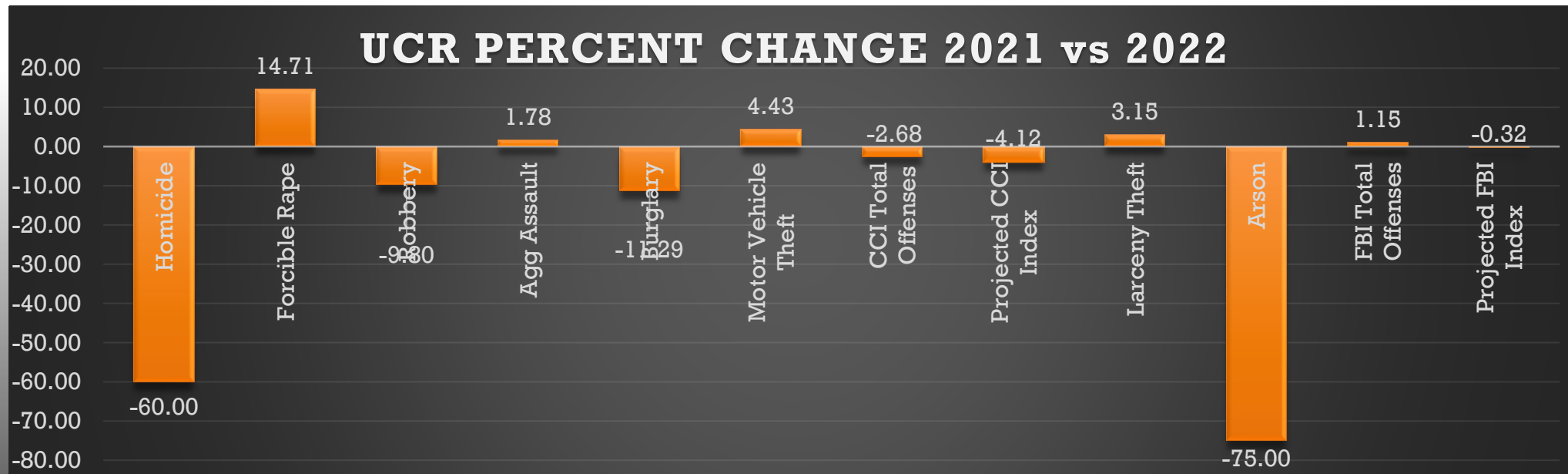
WIC 5150 Cases 2021 vs 2022

# NIBRS

In 2022 the Clovis Police Department switched over to the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS). This switch was required by the federal government and is now being used as the guide for reporting crime nationally.

The difference between UCR and NIBRS is the UCR only counted the highest crime, where NIBRS counts all crimes.

NIBRS will also show slightly different than the crimes in the slides above as person crimes is counted by the victim, not the case offense.

This is an example of how the information will look. This is six months information. All the information has not been finalized by California DOJ at this time
