NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Clovis will hold a public hearing on December 16, 2024, to gather public input regarding the potential composition of City Council election district boundaries.

The City Council of the City of Clovis is currently elected under an “at-large” election system, where Council members are elected by voters of the entire City. On October 7, 2024, the Council approved beginning the process to establish district-based elections beginning in 2026 in response to a threat of litigation related to the City’s current at-large election system. In a district-based election system, each Council member must reside within the designated election district boundary and is elected only by the voters in that district.

On December 16, 2024, the City Council will hold a second public hearing to gather input on composition of potential election districts in accordance with Elections Code section 10010.
