The City of Clovis Senior Activity Center, in cooperation with the Fresno-Madera Area Agency on Aging and Fresno County Economic Opportunity Commission are pleased to offer meal services for seniors age 60+. In-center meals are served at the Clovis Senior Activity Center at 735 Third Street in Clovis, Monday through Friday except the third Thursday of each month. Participants of in-center meals are not required to be a resident of Clovis but must be enrolled in the program. The form needs to be completed. Come to our front counter and we will fill it out for you.

Homebound meals are delivered to the home of Clovis seniors who are unable to visit the Center for meals and have difficulty shopping or preparing food. A home assessment is required prior to homebound deliveries to determine eligibility. This program is facilitated by the Fresno Madera Area on Aging and they may be reached by calling 559-214-0299 and asking for the home delivered program.

There is a Nutrition Form that must be completed before you are enrolled in the program for an In-Center Meal. These forms are required because of the funding we receive for this program. All individuals who participate in our In-Center nutrition program must have completed a new form annually starting every July 1st.

CLOVIS “IN-CENTER” MEAL INFORMATION

1. The suggested meal donation for seniors age 60+ is \$2.50. There is no obligation to contribute. A donation is purely voluntary and confidential. No eligible individual will be denied services because of a failure or inability to contribute. A senior's spouse under 60 may eat with the senior for the suggested meal donation of \$2.50, as long as the eligible person is having a meal that day. Anyone else under age 60 may eat at the non-senior price of \$6.27 per meal. You may bring your own silverware or the center will provide plastic cutlery.
2. Reservations are made for the following day or week when the participant signs in for the present day's meal. A reservation should be made only if the participant plans to attend the following day.
3. Meal reservations may also be made by telephone by calling the Center at 324-2750 before 11:00 a.m. the day before the participant plans to eat a meal. If you plan to attend for the entire week, you may make phone reservations for the current week.
4. Those without a reservation will be placed on a waiting list in the event of cancellations or no-shows. Names on the waiting list will be called in the order in which they were received if space becomes available. Being on the waiting list does not guarantee a meal. We cannot stretch meals for those without reservations.
5. Participants should arrive between 11:00 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. to sign in for the day's meal or their meal will be given to someone on the waiting list. Sign in must be completed by the participant himself/herself. No one can sign in for another person. Confirmed reservations are traded for a donation envelope at the time of sign in. A reservation must have been made previously in order to receive the envelope. Envelopes are used to count participants. Placing a donation inside the envelope is optional and not required to receive a meal.
6. Lunch is served between 11:45 a.m. and 12:15 p.m.. Donation envelopes are taken in the serving line in exchange for a plate, whether there is a donation in the envelope or it is empty. Those without an envelope may not pass through the serving line until all participants with an envelope have been served. There are no exceptions.
7. For health and safety reasons no food may be taken home from the meal site.
